Honors, AP and dual enrollment courses are weighted in cumulative percent GPA.

Practicums in various areas such as Social Media and Fine Arts are available for juniors and seniors and limited to one per year. Practicums are worth .25 credit but do not impact GPA or fulfill core graduation requirements.
