AP GOLD AWARD

STA was awarded the College Board's AP Gold Award for the third consecutive year.

The AP School Honor Roll recognizes schools whose Advanced Placement programs are delivering results for students while broadening access to advanced coursework. Schools can earn this recognition annually based on criteria that reflect a commitment to increasing college-going culture, providing opportunities for students to earn college credit, and maximizing college readiness. This recognition program began in 2023.

Gold Criteria:

- 65% or more of the graduating cohort took at least one AP exam during high school.
- 35% or more of the graduating cohort scored a 3 or higher on at least one AP exam during high school.
- 10% or more of the graduating cohort took five or more AP exams during high school with at least one being taken in the 9th or 10th grade.



Following AP exams in 2025, the College Board recognized over 75 STA students as AP scholars.

Each year, STA administers more than 375 AP exams. More than 75% of all STA students take one or more AP courses/exams and of those students, more than 75% score a 3 or higher on their exams.
